

Set up your Payroll Giving Donation



Payroll Giving, Workplace Giving or Give As You Earn (GAYE) – is a tax free way to donate to Registered Charities in the UK. Payroll donations are deducted from an employee's pre-tax or gross salary, reducing the total amount of income tax that the donor will need to pay. The employee has complete control on the sum of the donation and the length of time to give in this regular giving scheme. Donations are processed through the employee's Company Payroll department and continue until termination authorised by the employee.

- Easy to set-up, change and cancel – less admin work for you and the charity.
- You can give to more than one charity and any amount from £1 up, with no maximum
- Feel good factor – do it with your colleagues, team building, may want to do a charity day or a team activity to get more involved in the community
